Still aging in older barrels, the 2017 Chateauneuf du Pape Extrait is a blend of 80% Mourvèdre and 20% Grenache. It's darker and earthier than the regular cuvée, with blackberry and plum-like fruit accented by hints of mocha and cedar. Full-bodied, with velvety tannins, it should be cellared another year or two and then drink well for a decade or more.
