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Good sense of vibrancy here, it's upright with good acidity and snappy, springy tannins. Great energy and already showing some burgeoning complexity. Tannins are fresh and searching. No great depth, but lots of pleasure to offer in its youth. Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre grown on galets roulés and sand in lieux-dits L'Arnesque, Bois Dauphin and Cabrières, part destemmed, fermented in stainless steel, aged in foudre and demi-muid. 4,000 bottles made.
